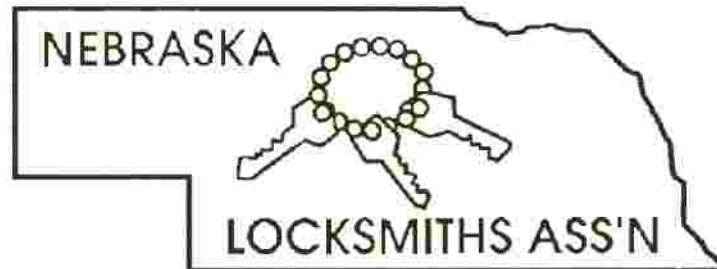

Meeting closed at 9:02

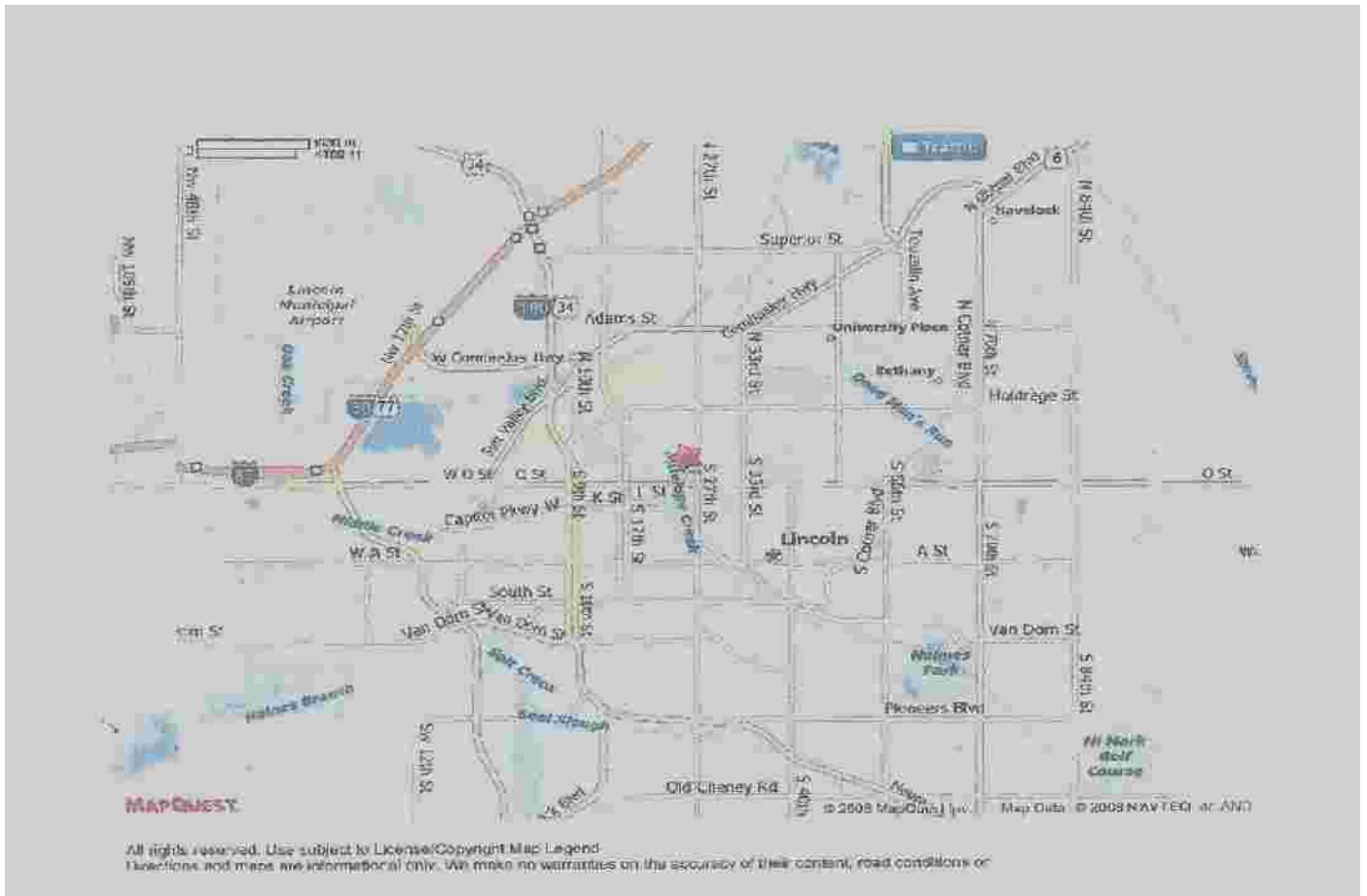
